Bible Promises

John 8:31-32, 34-36

Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." ... Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.

I will Drive them Out!

Little by little I will drive them out from before you, until you have increased, and you inherit the land. - Exodus 23:30

The Lord made a great promise to the children of Israel in the context of obedience to His instructions. The Israelites had to stay loyal to the Lord and to worship Him only. Remember, the Lord will keep His promises as long as you are keeping your eyes on Him and do what is right before His sight.

Did You Know?

Richard Wurmbrand, who wrote the book "Tortured for Christ," was a prisoner of the gospel in the 60's and very sick, to the point of death. He was sent to Room #4, a room designated for the people with no hope of recovery. Richard began to serve other prisoners and even gave them his own food. He gave away his slice of bread and spoke to the prisoners about Jesus, the Savior, the Author of eternal life. The prisoners were listening and every sick person who was sent to Room#4 accepted Jesus. Deliverance from hate, jealousy, pride, philosophy, selfishness, bitterness, immorality, was experienced by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The Ambassador in Chains

The Apostle Paul was an ambassador for Christ in chains, "that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains. (Ephesians 6:19b-20a). Paul was unstoppable in his work of the gospel. His example is contagious, powerful, remarkable, valuable, and to be followed. Richard Wurmbrand was condemned to 14 years in prison for preaching the gospel. Although he was dying of tuberculosis in a prison in the northwest of Romania, every person that was brought to his room accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior. Later he recovered from his sickness and continued to spread the gospel to the persecuted church worldwide. Let's follow in the footsteps of these heroes of faith, looking unto Jesus as the Supreme Example.
