Bible Promises

John 15:4-10

Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

Discipleship

Paul withdrew with "the disciples, reasoning daily in the School of Tyrannus" (Acts 19:9c). Decades after Jesus ascended to heaven, Paul was still focusing on making disciples. This month, pray and ask the Lord to open a door for you so you can help a friend or a relative to know more about Jesus and the Bible. Next month will be the Month of Discipleship.

The Book of Acts

It was written by Luke, the doctor who wrote also the Gospel of Luke. The Key verse is Acts 1:8, "And you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit will come upon you." The Book of Acts records the spread of Christianity from Jerusalem, to Samaria, Antioch in Syria, Asia Minor, Europe, all the way to Rome, the capital of the Roman Empire. The Key words are "witnessing, praying, & power." The Book can be outlined as: a) Peter's Ministry (chapters 1-12), b) Paul's Ministry (chapters 13-28).

The Gift of Encouragement

This is a very important gift in the body of Christ and it means to exhort, give confidence, support, comfort, lift up the spirit, and inspire another believer to continue the race that is before him/her. Encouragement leads to service, church growth, spiritual growth, and should be done with the help of the Holy Spirit.
